To swap out the hose is not difficult but takes a little time and a little care.

First remove the hose sleeve.
 Use a junior hack saw or snips to cut down the sleeve and peal it back.
 DO NOT cut across the sleeve Once sleeve is loose pull the hose off. Check the hose tail hasn't been damaged during removal of the sleeve.

2. Now fit the new hose.

Make sure it is 4.8mm (5mm) hose
If replacement hose has fittings on
it simply cut one end off.

Slide an appropriate O ring over the blank end
and push the new hose firmly onto the tail end.
A little washing up liquid may help.

3. Secure O clip
Using pincers firmly squeeze the
ears of the O clip to secure
the hose in place.
