

Bergeon have advised of some specificity with regards the use of this tool:

- The lever must always be pushed against the wooden handle
- The tool has no locking system; meaning if the lever is lifted up from the handle the tool will fall apart requiring you to rebuild it.

The following provides instruction on how to reassemble your tool:

1. Unscrew the white collet off the bottom.
2. The main metal body with spring slots in from the bottom with the larger slot facing the wooden handle
3. Drop the collet into the top end followed by the smaller heavier spring, then the ball bearing
4. To attach the handle with the notch facing upwards, slot it through the larger slot on the first collet into the smaller slot opposite, which in turn pushes the ball bearing down giving tension.

Now screw the white collar back on the bottom
