

Using curved Gilbow shears, cut the disc to the desired size to form a circular pendant. Remember to remove any sharp edges using the appropriate file from the set.

Step 2 ~ Creating the domed effect

Place your cut disc over the appropriate sized dome on the wooden doming block. Using the correct sized punch from the set, firmly hammer the punch square on, into the disc and doming block. This will create the perfect dish effect.

Step 3 ~ Texturing your lewellery

Using a jewellery drill bit, drill two holes to thread the cord through to make your necklace. Using the burr and abrasive brush, texture the dishes to achieve that decorative look. Make use of the files again by smoothing out the holes you have made or add further texture to your pieces.
